Drinking Water Testing Clinic

Do you rely on a private well for drinking water?

As part of its Private Well Education Program, the University of Minnesota Extension is offering **free drinking water testing kits** in collaboration with Well Aware.

Drinking water samples will be tested for the following contaminants of concern:

- Nitrate
- Coliform Bacteria
- Arsenic
- Manganese
- Lead
